Community Vocational Training

Aagahi – Adult Literacy Programme

Launched in 2004, Aagahi provides literacy skills to women from rural areas and urban slums

Improvement in women's functional Urdu & Math literacy along with household budgeting, creating health and hygiene awareness, and teaching them to monitor their child's education

With classes held twice a year, the three-month course comprises workbooks to teach phonetics-based recognition of alphabets, words, and sentences, and to teach basic numeracy

Awarded the UNESCO Confucius Prize for Literacy in 2017

- Vision: To provide clean drinking water to communities in a sustainable manner




- Community-sized filtration plants set up within TCF school premises, for both the school and the community
- Team of trained plant operators and technicians
- Water quality testing is independently done by the Pakistan Council of Research in Water Resources (PCRWR)

Water filtration plants at 36 TCF Schools

Two-thirds of water plants are solar-powered

30% are Reverse Osmosis

Serving 48,000 beneficiaries daily

Mission:

Poverty alleviation and social development in communities around TCF Schools

Vision:

To enable community women around TCF Schools to attain technical skills, enabling them to earn a livelihood and support their families

Community Vocational Training

- Teach women tailoring, embroidery, and entrepreneurship skills so they can earn an income by working from home or as apprentices at the vocational centers
- Centers take work orders, including stitching of TCF school uniforms
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- Currently, TCF is operating 16 vocational training centers for community women across Punjab, Sindh and Baluchistan
